

EARLY RESPONSE TEAM (ERT) TRAINING

UMCOR Early Response Teams (ERTs) fill a specific need in the early days following a disaster — after the first-response emergency workers finish and before recovery/rebuild teams begin.

Under very specific guidelines, ERTs assist survivors by cleaning out damaged homes, removing debris, and tarping roofs. Above all, ERT members provide a caring Christian presence in the midst of devastation.

All ERT members are trained by authorized UMCOR trainers to assist survivors without causing further harm or being a burden to the community.

Students are given identification badges as evidence of a successful completion of the basic class. These badges are valid for three years and are required to enter most disaster areas.
